Mr. Crawford stated #3 bears down in to him and causes him to check his horse and lose all momentum. Mr. Kimura stated when he went to change his whip hand his horse lugged in on him. Claim of foul upheld.

"Divine Nectar" #3 (Kazushi Kimura) finished 1st placed 3rd for causing interference to "Bella Loco" #6 (Juan Crawford) the 3rd place finisher.
