Key Race of the Day – Race 6 – Starter Optional Claiming – 5 1/2 Furlongs

The late double gets underway in race six, a starter optional claiming event for the girls at five and a half furlongs on the main track and features a field of six. In terms of the pace, it appears a few horses could attempt to vie for the early lead, and that would be a dream setup for **#2 Ashcar Nellie**, who has run well in her three outings this year and continues to improve. Even though she was defeated last time out by **Because**, she was motoring late and almost got the job done. She absolutely loves this track and can hopefully save ground and roll late. Another mare who loves the dirt at Fort Erie is **#4 Legs Like Flatter**, who picked up her second win of the year in her most recent start while facing \$5k claimers. She steps up in class to a level she tried once last season, but that was up at Woodbine. Her only poor race at the Fort was two back, when she didn't get the trip she wanted and with her Beyer last time out of a 65, she fits nicely here and may offer a little value. **#6 Because** won last time out in her Fort Erie debut and got a trip quite close to the pacesetters and was game to the wire. The barn does very well with last out winners and the draw figures to work well for her, especially considering her stablemate to her inside doesn't have a ton of early foot and she may be able to clear many (if not all). With that said, it appears she may have to work for it a bit more if horses like Leziate and Get Out the Vote try to go early on and maybe that hinders her a bit.
