Backstretch:

Jockey Juan Crawford and DeSean Bynoe excused from their mounts today.

Trainer Michael Cohen attended to deal with penalty regarding the positive test of Bingo's Grind from Race 5, June 29, 2026. Mr. Cohen accepted the settlement agreement of a 3-day suspension, August 3, 4 and 5, 2026 and a \$500.00 monetary penalty, payable at the conclusion of the suspension. A loss of purse earnings for the horse and revised order of finish for the race will be forthcoming.

Race 1, #2 Kentucky Bill, K. Johnson, 1st, bore out backstretch run, did come out to, and make incidental contact with #3 Easter Sunday Girl, no placings required, rest ok

Race 2, #2 Blue Max, K. Johnson, 2nd stumbled after the start prior to crossing over to the main track from the chute, it did tighten up as #3 Attestation, D. Gaskin, 4th, was dropping in slightly and #1 Fairway to Heaven C. Lee, 3rd, was drifting out, no placings required, rest ok

Informed from broadcast that the front tower turf was unavailable.

Race 3, Turf, Jockey claim of foul, #1 S. Jadoo, 4th, on Alzado, on #6 Rose For Carrick, 3rd, Brian Cheyne, into the far turn, upon review of the back tower and apex camera angles and speaking with both riders, it was apparent that it may have been the #5, E. Zenteno on Woodglen Court, may have been laying in making it tight for #1 as it has to check on the inside, the #6 does stay out and #1 beat #5 in the order of finish, claim of foul disallowed.

Jockey Leo Salles excused from the remainder of his mounts following the third race.

Race 4, All clear, Jockey Robert Stewart cited for an urging violation, did use the crop in an overhand position, was afforded a review, is a second violation in a year, is issued a \$300.00 monetary penalty and a one-day suspension, August 3, 2026. TB Ruling #3827915.

Race 5, #3 Citori, D Fukumoto, 6th, stumbled badly at the start, #2 Vandoo, E. Zenteno, slight stumble after start, #4 Bridge to Nowhere bore out at start, rest ok.

Race 6, Turf, Jockey claim of foul, #5, Fast and Ready, J. Alderson, 6th, on #1 Silent Miracle, I. Mosqueira, 3rd, around the 1/16th pole, upon review of the front tower from the main track, and upper pan, it was inconclusive if the #1 did not leave enough room as #5 does check, Alderson felt he came down to him, Mosqueira said he stayed straight. Claim of foul disallowed
